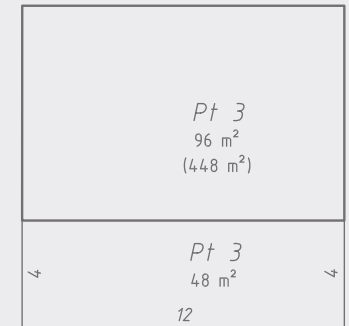
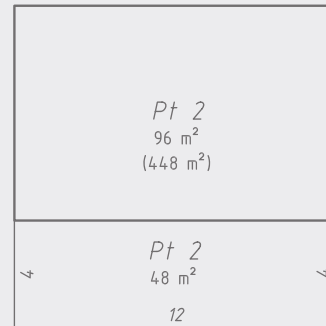
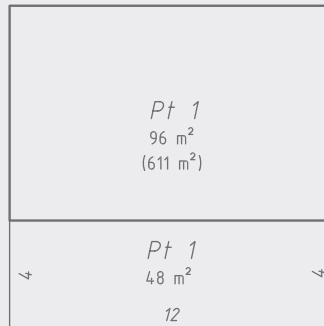


PERIMETER OF PARCEL

Stratum Notes:

The stratum of the part lots extends from five (5) metres below to ten (10) metres above the upper surface level of the lowest ground floor in the main building that forms part of that lot.

The boundaries of the lots or parts of the lots which are buildings shown on the Strata Plan are the external surfaces of those buildings as provided by Section 3AB of the Strata Titles Act 1985.

Where 2 lots have a common or party wall, or have buildings on them which are joined, the centre plane of the wall or the plane at which they are joined is the boundary.

The distances are from boundaries or the external faces of the walls.

Unless shown otherwise, all angles are 90 degrees.
